Add Custom Field

https://pslcdatashop.web.cmu.edu/services/datasets/[id]/customfields/add

- Add and describe a new custom field for a given dataset by providing either a tab-delimited or pslc_datashop_message xml request.
- Use the format request parameter to indicate an XML or tab-delimited request. Default is tab-delimited.
- Outcome of request returned as a pslc_datashop_message.

Example Add Custom Field Request & Response (tab-delimited):

Get Custom Field Data

https://pslcdatashop.web.cmu.edu/services/datasets/[id]/[?samples/id]/customfields/[?id]

- Get custom field data, indexed by transaction ID, for transactions within the specified sample & custom field ID.
- Omit sample ID and custom field ID to get all custom fields for the 'All Data' sample.
- Use the format request parameter to indicate how you'd like the results returned (tab-delimited or in a pslc_datashop_message XML document. Default is tab-delimited.

Set Custom Field Data

https://pslcdatashop.web.cmu.edu/services/datasets/[id]/customfields/[id]/set

- Annotate transaction data with custom fields after creating the custom field via the Add Custom Field service.
- Supports annotation for a single custom field across transactions, so to annotate a transaction with multiple custom fields, use multiple requests.
- Use the format request parameter to indicate an XML or tab-delimited request. Default is tab-delimited.

Get Custom Field Metadata

- Get a listing of custom fields with metadata for a given dataset or for a single custom field.
- Use the mine parameter to retrieve only customs fields owned by you. Default is false.

Modify Custom Field Name

- Modify a custom field's name (this can only be done by the owner of the custom field).
- Use the format request parameter to indicate an XML or tab-delimited request. Default is tab-delimited.

Modify Custom Field Description

- Modify a custom field's description (this can only be done by the owner of the custom field).
